

Suspect identified in Shingletown double homicide

SHINGLETOWN, Calif. — The suspect in Saturday's double homicide in Shingletown has been identified as 35-year-old Daun Eric Sanders, according to the Shasta County Sheriff's Office.

During the shooting investigation, Deputies and officers with the Redding Police Department went to Sanders' residence at 27211 Gail Lane in Shingletown Saturday afternoon but did not find him. Gail Lane is off Dersch Road, south of Highway 44, about 20 miles east of Redding.

Officials say they are still searching for Sanders and that he should be considered armed and dangerous. It is believed that he took off in a dark colored pickup truck just before officials arrived.

Officers were looking for the suspect in a triple-shooting earlier at nearby 27325 Gail Lane. Officers responded to a call at that location around 11 a.m. for a report of several people shot.

Officers found three victims at that location. Two were pronounced dead at the scene and one was taken to the hospital and is currently listed in critical condition.

The names of the victims have yet to be released, and no word on a possible motive.

The SCSO is warning the public not to confront Sanders if they see him.
