USING EITHER:** ● **Q CODE PROCEDURE,** OR
● **FORMAT WHISKEY PROCEDURE.**

● **Q CODE PROCEDURE** (includes the “slash procedure”).

[IF USE ANY OTHER Q CODES, THEY MUST FOLLOW THE SLASH PROCEDURE!]

● “ THIS IS K6PDS, QXi D QXA , OUT”.
EXAMPLE of - “ALL OKAY AND NOTHING TO REPORT AT MY QTH.”

● “ THIS IS K6PDS / Y OUT”.
EXAMPLE of - I am okay and do not need assistance.

● “ K6PDS /A /F /Y OUT”. ***
● “ / [insert Brevity ID (Tactical)] [FROM V3R] /A /F /Y OUT”. ***
Examples of – LISTING SITUATIONS, AND THAT
I AM OKAY AND DO NOT NEED ASSISTANCE.

● “K6PDS / A / F /Y QWA OUT”
EXAMPLE of a Q Code following the slash procedure.

*** In these examples, be sure to advise whether you need assistance, or that you don’t need assistance (i.e., /Y or /Z).

● **FORMAT WHISKEY** (plain English):

● “K6PDS, Electricity is off, telephone land lines not working,
I am okay and do not need assistance. OUT.

Q CODE SLASH PROCEDURE:

/A	ELECTRICITY IS OFF.
/B	TELEPHONE - LAND LINES NOT WORKING.
/C	CELL PHONES NOT WORKING.
/D	911 SERVICE NOT WORKING.
/F	INTERNET IS NOT WORKING.
/G	FLOODING IN AREA.
/J	HIGH WINDS / STORM DAMAGE.
/L	WATER SERVICES NOT WORKING.
/M	HEAVY SNOW / SNOW CHAINS REQUIRED.
/N	I NEED PROPANE
/O	I NEED FIREWOOD
/Y	I AM OKAY AND DO NOT NEED ASSISTANCE.
/Z	I NEED ASSISTANCE
NOTE: YOU CAN ALSO FOLLOW ABOVE BY INSERTING OTHER Q CODES AS NEEDED AND PLAIN ENGLISH (BRIEF). E.G., “ K6PDS /A /Y QWA Q [INSERT OTHER] OUT ”.	

Note: You are advising only of non working utilities or potential problems. It is assumed that if you don’t report the item, then such situation is not present. Your LOCATION (Q code) need not be stated unless you are NOT at your home QTH.

Note: if during NET, station advises “ ... /z” or “I need assistance” and it is not an emergency situation, then Net Control should have that station and another station QSY to simplex (e.g., ALPHA 4 or CHARLIE 3) (DO NOT STATE FREQUENCY ON AIR USE CH. ID ONLY) TO DISCUSS SITUATION AND THEN REPORT BACK INTO THE NET AND GIVE A SHORT DIRECT REPORT OF SITUATION AND NEEDS, IF ANY. Q CODES MAY BE APPROPRIATE. Why? THE WORLD DOESN’T NEED TO KNOW THAT “JOE” RAN OUT OF PROPANE OR FIREWOOD, OR, IS NOT ABLE TO DIAL 911.

DURING SNOW STORMS, ETC... 760 RPTR MAY GO DOWN WHEN SOLAR CAN’T RECHARGE BATTERIES. ALSO, YOUR OWN BATTERIES MAY BE LIMITED.

ACCORDINGLY, BRIEF & ACCURATE REPORTING IS CRITICAL.
