Format Tango 9M (updated 2024 11 13) now shows the "slash codes" (Q codes) (with black background and white printing; AND

KEY WORDS are likewise shown with black background and white printing.

YOU CAN USE EITHER OF ABOVE METHODS (Q CODES OR KEY WORDS) TO REPORT.

Of course the Q Codes are much easier for mapping (because Q Codes merely have to be circled and are in alphabetical order on the forms), but we are trying to facilitate that you may not have your Format Tango 9 in front of you.

So, below are the two ways that INDIVIDUAL Reports can be done (use either). FOR EAMPLE:

Please use the Q codes OR the KEY WORDS specified.

Please don't provide extraneous comments (e.g. you were busy feeding the dog, ... didn't hear the radio go off, .. eating dinner, etc...).

INDIVIDUAL STATION REPORTS:
