

DRILL #1 (VERSION 20190613): NON EMERGENCY TRAFFIC

Stations in Divisions 1, 2, and 3 will report as follows – these are the DRILL FACTS:

- Black out (All Comms of, electricity off, no landline telephone, no cell phone, no 911, no internet)
- Earthquake windows, dishes rattle
- I AM OKAY AND DO NOT NEED ASSISTANCE. [IF REPORT FOR AREA (E.G., LEAD TO AREA COORDINATOR...) – MY AREA OKAY, AND ANY ASSISTANCE NEEDS IN MY AREA ARE BEING TAKEN CARE OF BY MY AREA. NO OUT OF AREA ASSISTANCE NEEDED AT THIS TIME.]

Stations in Division 4 and 5 will report as follows – these are the DRILL FACTS:

- Black out (All Comms off, electricity off, no landline telephone, no cell phone, no 911, no internet)
- Earthquake – pictures move, doors swing, small items on floor
- I AM OKAY AND DO NOT NEED ASSISTANCE. [IF REPORT FOR AREA (E.G., LEAD TO AREA COORDINATOR...) – MY AREA OKAY, AND ANY ASSISTANCE NEEDS IN MY AREA ARE BEING TAKEN CARE OF BY MY AREA. NO OUT OF AREA ASSISTANCE NEEDED AT THIS TIME.]

  DIVISIONS 4, and 5	
Sample INDIVIDUAL Neighborhood Reports to your NEIGHBORHOOD LEAD	
PLAIN ENGLISH - USE FORMAT T9M	OR Q CODE - USE FORMAT T9M
You Say- when Lead advises you to “go” “DRILL – ROCK CREEK LEAD, this is ROCK CREEK JOE, I AM AT HOME, black out –all Comms, Electric, utility OFF; Earthquake, PICTURES MOVE, DOORS SWINGS, SMALL ITEMS ON FLOOR; I am okay and do not need assistance; QWA – DRILL OUT”	You Say- when Lead advises you to “go” “DRILL – ROCK CREEK LEAD, this is ROCK CREEK JOE, QTH B QXi D /F /M5 /Y QWA DRILL OUT” For “/” say “slash”
SPEAK CLEARLY AND SLOWLY – YOUR LEAD MUST RECORD EACH REPORT.	

NEXT LEVEL, AFTER RELAY FROM LEAD TO AREA COORDINATOR,

IS RELAY FROM THE AREA COORDINATOR TO THE HAM NET CONTROL STATION:

NOT APPLICABLE	AREA COORDINATOR SAIS:- when NCS advises you to “go” “DRILL – NET CONTROL THIS IS ROCK CREEK COORDINATOR REPORT ROCK CREEK, DIVISION 4 ___ STNS REPORTING QTH N QXi D /F /M5 /Y QWA DRILL [CALL SIGN] OUT” For “/” say “slash”
SPEAK CLEARLY AND SLOWLY – NCS MUST RECORD EACH REPORT AND THEN DO MAPPING, ANALYSIS, TRIANGULATION (IF APPLIES), MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS, ETC...	

DRILL NOTES:

HAMS – USE FORMAT TANGO 9A

NEIGHBORHOODS USE FORMAT TANGO 9M

- AREA COORDINATORS ARE TO RELAY INTO HAM NET USING Q CODE SYSTEM (LEADS SHOULD LEARN TO DO THIS SAME PROCEDURE IN RELAYING TO THEIR AREA COORDINATOR).

E.G.,

“DRILL - NET CONTROL THIS IS VILLAGE COORDINATOR - REPORT”

“VILLAGE, DIVISION 3,

_____ STATIONS REPORTING

QTH N QXi D /F /M4 /Y QWA DRILL [CALL SIGN], OUT”

NOTE:

“**QWA**” is a Brevity Fire Watch code. It means that you took very specific steps! (IT DOES NOT MEAN THE SAME THING AS ALL OKAY).

See Format Mike 7 for the Brevity Fire Watch Codes (at the Radio Emergency Page – at WWW.ShastaDefense.com)

“QWA” means: “I have made outdoor observations at current location, and taking into account any other reports I may have just made (e.g., QWK - known reported fire, etc...) / All Appears fine - No SUSPECT Smoke or Fire observed (either visual or smell). I did NOT do a search. I merely made a 360 degree turn and observed ground, trees and sky areas as I made observations and did not smell any suspect smoke and did not see any suspect smoke or fire. If any station has additional and/or contrary information please call now.”

You will only say “QWA” on the radio. Do NOT read the above over the radio (you are wasting battery, preventing anyone else from passing emergency / priority traffic, and holding up the nets (i.e., your neighborhood net and the entire Ham net which is waiting for your area report). However, you are to actually do the above steps for the QWA. You do this between the time the Net is activated and the time when Net Control (or your Area Lead) starts taking reports.

Following an Earthquake, or other event, I am sure we all agree that checking for fires is a good idea.
